The successful candidate will be given the opportunity to gain valuable fundraising experience in the nonprofit sector, as well as gain insight into the workings of an international NGO that is recognized for its innovation in the field of 'Sport for Development'. You will have the opportunity to work closely with Skateistan's Development Manager as well as a motivated and innovative fundraising team. You'll be the lead on handling grants support, ensuring all written communication with major donors is streamlined and consistent with Skateistan's mission, and help seek out new revenue streams for Skateistan from foundations, governments and other institutions. There is also the opportunity to get creative with the team, assisting with Skateistan's Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning activities. Enthusiasm is key as it's a big year for Skateistan in 2017!

This is a volunteer position of 16 hours per week, from August through January 2017. This uncompensated position provides office perks, flexible hours and hands-on experience, and is based at Skateistan's headquarters in Berlin, Germany.
